Article IV “The Committees”

Article IV of the Constitution of the Hispanic American Club establish the creation of permanent Committees. - Prepare budgets when necessary for each event.
- Notify the local High School of the availability of funds to help Hispanic students.
- Attend with the president of the Club the presentation of the scholarship awards.
- Review and present to the BOD qualifications for the scholarship awards for their review and approval.
- Negotiate on behalf of the Club rental of different places for scholarship activities.
- Notify the Director of the Public Relations committee of each scheduled activity for the purpose of advertisement in the local news paper.
- Committee, Director will report directly to the President.
