Article IV “The Committees”

Article IV of the Constitution of the Hispanic American Club establish the creation of permanent Committees. The Directors of these committees will be appointed by the President and will serve under his discretion and of the Board of Directors. The Committee Directors will appoint the members of their respective committee. Each committee will consist of a Director, a sub Director and assistants. - Prepare on the monthly basis or as necessary, detailed expenses report to the treasurer.
- Director reports directly to the President.
